design/ your dross to consume and your gold to refine.

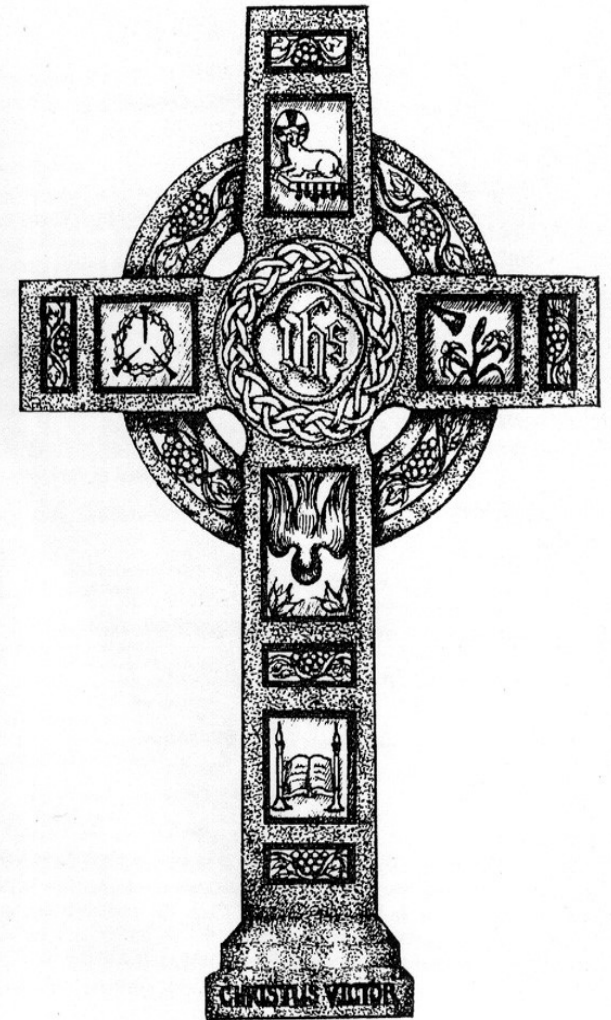
"E'en down to old age all my people shall prove/ my sovereign,
